COMSTECH the Ministerial Standing Committee on Scientific and Technological Cooperation of the OIC (Organization of Islamic Cooperation) was established by the Third Islamic Summit of OIC held at Makkah, Saudi Arabia in January 1981.

The President of Pakistan is Chairman of COMSTECH. The core mandate of COMSTECH is to strengthen cooperation among OIC Member States in science and technology (S&T), and enhance their capabilities through training in emerging areas, undertake follow-up-actions and implementation of the resolutions of the OIC, and to draw up programs and submit proposals designed to increase the capability of the Muslim countries in S&T.

COMSTECH objectives include, assessment of human and material resources, identification of S&T needs, capacity building, enhancing cooperation and coordination, and creation of an effective institutional structure in OIC states.

Al-Shifa Trust was established in 1985. President of Pakistan is the patron in chief of the trust. It is a non-governmental, non-political, charitable organization. The aims and objectives of the trust are prevention and control of blindness by providing standard and sustainable eye care services that are accessible and affordable, human resource development through training of doctors, nurses and paramedics, creating awareness about eye diseases in the general public through camping activity and establishing facilities for research in ophthalmology.

Al-Shifa Trust comprises of four tertiary care eye hospitals and a research center to conduct high-impact eye research.

Al Shifa has a teaching and training arm by the name of Pakistan Institute of Ophthalmology which runs post graduate courses for Ophthalmologists, Master in Public Health, Bachelors degree in Optometry and Orthoptics and various other paramedical courses.

5. Pediatric Ophthalmology




Eye Surgery Camps for Cataract in OIC Member States
