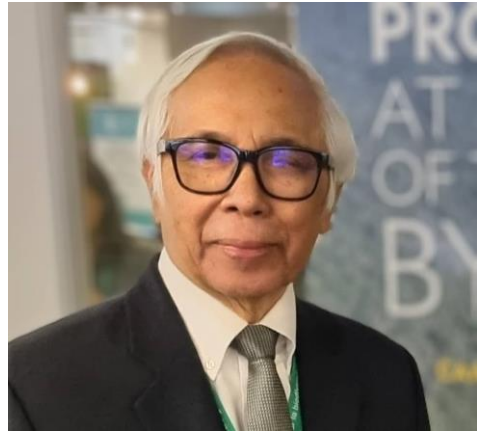


Professor Zakri Abdul Hamid

Zakri is a distinguished professor and founding director of the newly established International Institute of Science Diplomacy and Sustainability at UCSI University, a leading private university in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.



He is currently the fifth holder of the Tun Hussein Onn Chair in International Studies at the Institute of Strategic and International Studies, Malaysia. He is also the Chairman of Atri Advisory, an international consultancy advising governments and multilateral organisations on sustainable development and Joint-Chairman of the Malaysian Industry-Government Group on High Technology (MIGHT).

He is a former science adviser to the Prime Minister of Malaysia and a former member of the Scientific Advisory Board to UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon. He is a vice-chair of the council of the UN Technology Bank for Least-Developed Countries based in Turkey and a distinguished fellow of the Global Federation of Competitiveness Council.

Zakri is a founding fellow of the Academy of Sciences Malaysia and the International Science Council, respectively while holding fellowships of The World Academy of Sciences, the Islamic World Academy of Sciences and the World Academy of Art and Science.
